QUESTIONS

Always apply these principles during your growth group:

1. Read the passage the sermon was based on.
2. Always refer to the Bible.
3. Pepper your discussion with Scripture, allowing God to be the final authority in your discussions.
4. Always try to have everyone practically apply the message using the Level 3 questions.

Are you still praying for the three people needing salvation?

LEVEL 1 | “WHAT” QUESTIONS

- 1) (All-Play: Everyone answers) After reading this entire Psalm; ask this question: What is the central theme or focus of this Psalm? (No single “right” answer)
- 2) What is your reaction to the statement: “When the wicked win.” Aren’t the good guys supposed to win?
- 3) What promises do you see for you in this Psalm? (One or two specific verses)
- 4) What three things are we to do when the wicked win that Pastor Scott spoke about?
- 5) What is “thru-vision”?

LEVEL 2 | “WHEN” QUESTIONS

- 6) (Share about) When have you ever seen a terrible injustice and said “that’s not fair!!!”
- 7) (Share about) When have you ever taken things into your own hands and didn’t wait on God?
- 8) (Share about) Where right now do you need to trust and wait on His deliverance and not take matters into your own hands?

LEVEL 3 | “HOW” QUESTIONS

- 9) How does a Christian develop and grow more and more “thru-vision”? How can you?
- 10) How does the final outcome of the wicked help you to trust God more?
- 11) How can we in practice fix our eyes on Jesus while we are in the midst of the wicked winning?
- 12) How can you continue in hope and endurance and motivation to do what is right while the wicked are winning?
- 13) How can the promises you thought of earlier (question #3) help you to press on and not give up?
- 14) Ask the question: “Is anyone facing a significant decision this week?” How can this MiniChurch help?
