QUESTIONS

Always apply these principles during your growth group:

1. Read the passage the sermon was based on.
2. Always refer to the Bible.
3. Pepper your discussion with Scripture, allowing God to be the final authority in your discussions.
4. Always try to have everyone practically apply the message using the Level 3 questions.

Are you still praying for the three people needing salvation?

LEVEL 1 | “WHAT” QUESTIONS

- 1) (All-Play: Everyone answers) Pastor Andrew mentioned several times: “Good works don’t save us – God’s work saves us.” If a new Christian or a visitor to our church came and asked you “What does that statement mean?” What would you tell them?
- 2) Read statements #1, 2 & 3. (From the notes) Also read the associated scriptures. Ask the questions: What does this mean? What implications are there for me in this statement?
- 3) What are the four categories that people “fit” into according to Pastor Andrew?*

LEVEL 2 | “WHEN” QUESTIONS

- 4) (Share about) When was the last time you shared the Gospel with someone?
- 5) (Share about) When did you first come to realize the truth of the statement mentioned in question #1?
- 6) (Share about) Where do you need to stop trying to “earn brownie points” with God and instead rest in what He has already done for you?

LEVEL 3 | “HOW” QUESTIONS

- 7) How does the fact that your own “good works” are not counted toward your salvation at all impact you?
- 8) How can you share this amazing fact; that God accepts us as we are when we come to Him?
- 9) How can you begin a conversation with someone this week about the Gospel?
- 10) Ask the question: “Is anyone facing a significant decision this week?” How can this MiniChurch help?

*1. Those who have accepted, understood and know the Gospel. 2. Those who have heard the Gospel; and think they understand it, but do not. 3. Those who have rejected the Gospel. 4. Those who have never heard the Gospel.
