QUESTIONS

Always apply these principles during your growth group:

1. Read the passage the sermon was based on.
2. Always refer to the Bible.
3. Pepper your discussion with Scripture, allowing God to be the final authority in your discussions.
4. Always try to have everyone practically apply the message using the Level 3 questions.

Are you still praying for the three people needing salvation?

LEVEL 1 | “WHAT” QUESTIONS

- 1) (All-Play: Everyone answers) Read #1: In what ways was our spiritual condition apart from Christ like the condition of a physically dead person? What does a dead person need the most?
- 2) What three forces of darkness dominated our lives before our deliverance to Christ?
- 3) Read #2: What did God do? Did we help Him at all? Why? / Why not?
- 4) What terms does use Paul to describe God’s mercy, love and grace in these verses (4 – 7)?
- 5) What reasons as to why God saved you do you find in verses 1 – 3? How about verses 4 – 7? in verses 4 – 9 God is doing everything. What is our responsibility found in verse 10b?
- 6) Read #3: In what ways are you walking in the good works that God prepared in advance for you?

LEVEL 2 | “WHEN” QUESTIONS

- 7) (Share about) When has it impacted you where you would spend all eternity if it weren’t for the grace of God?
- 8) (Share about) When have you been truly thankful for His grace, love and mercy to you?
- 9) (Share about) Where do you need to share the good news of what God has done for you?

LEVEL 3 | “HOW” QUESTIONS

- 10) (All-Play: Everyone answers) Thankfulness, humility and gratitude toward our God who saved us should mark every believer. How can we maintain these characteristics and also avoid the fleshly opposites; thanklessness, pride & cold ingratitude that would try to creep into our thoughts?
- 11) If God had not intervened in our life; our end would be an eternal place of punishment called hell. How are we to go about repaying God for His indescribable gift? (Since we can never repay Him... what are we to do? Does verse 10 give us a hint?)
- 12) How are we to discover the good works He has prepared in advance for us so we will “walk in them?”
- 13) Ask the question: “Is anyone facing a significant decision this week?” How can this MiniChurch help?
