LEVEL 1 | “WHAT” QUESTIONS

- 1) (All share) Zac said: “We live in an age of personal insignificance and great loneliness.” What implications or consequences does this have for how we should view one another, as well as newcomers to Hope Chapel?
- 2) What did Jesus say would be the hallmark of His disciples? Why is this important?
- 3) What would you say is the purpose of the church?
- 4) What enabled the early church and Christians today to faithfully endure and overcome persecution and suffering?
- 5) What are the two aspects of community Zac mentioned?

LEVEL 2 | “WHEN” QUESTIONS

- 6) (Share about) When have you experienced growth and/or progress in your life as a result of the community at Hope Chapel?
- 7) (Share about) Where do you fit into the community of Hope Chapel?

LEVEL 3 | “HOW” QUESTIONS

- 8) Zac said: “God’s loves love, among God’s people is the most convincing argument for the truth of the gospel to the world.” How can you take responsibility to make this truth evident at Hope Chapel?
- 9) Ask the question: “Is anyone facing a significant decision this week?” How can this mini church help?
- 10) How can you be intentional about improving the health and welfare of the body of believers at Hope Chapel?
