How should believers use money?

Jesus teaches five facts about money (vss 9-13)

1) Vs 9 - Money will ultimately <u>fail</u> (not if, but when).

2) *Vs 10* - Money is a <u>very little</u> thing.

 Vs 11 - Money is not the <u>true riches</u> but God gives us these later if we are <u>faithful</u>. Vs 12 - Money, <u>which belongs to another</u>, is simply to <u>test</u> our faithfulness as a manager, so God can ultimately reward us with our own.

 Vs 13 - Money is also a <u>test</u> to see if we will serve <u>God</u> only and not <u>riches</u>.
